Introduction of Speakers 論壇講演者介紹

**WU, Xiong Zhi**

Prof. Wu was born and raised from a famous TCM family in Sichuan. He was the chosen one in the family to inherit the knowledge accumulated by generations. With his big heart on promoting TCM, he has putting tremendous energy and time to establish a scholarship for supporting poor yet enthusiastic TCM students, an online platform for sharing TCM teaching of Classics (Shanghan Lun and Jin Kuei), and latest the "Taihu Academy", the online e-school for people to learn and share classical TCM lessons and Chinese classical literatures such as Yi-Ching. So far Dr. Wu has brought more than 100,000 students globally to get into the study of Chinese medicine via internet. His pursuit of knowledge in medical field began at the tender age of 6. In his endeavors, As the keynote speaker, Dr. Wu would like to present "Chaining the Pearls of TCM formula". It likens Chinese herbs and their related remedies to the uniqueness of a pearl in that they are actually related and were developed from relatives. Dr. Wu will use unique principles he developed to show everyone how to analyze those classica TCM formulas, he will also be addressing those interesting topics such as TCM and hormones, calcium, iron and bones.

**ZAIDMAN, Ron**

Dr. Zaidman is the President of Five Branches University in California. He holds a Stanford University MBA degree and is fluent in five languages. He has a passion for Chinese culture and has dedicated over 35 years of his life to traditional Chinese medicine. Back in 1983, he established the California Five Branches University of Traditional Chinese Medicine. He is also the Chairman of the ACAOM Site Visit Team. In his upcoming presentation, Dr. Zaidman will go in depth about the development of traditional Chinese medicine education in the United States. He will also address its current structure, culture, management systems and future directions. Furthermore, Dr. Zaidman will also compare and contrast the status of the traditional Chinese medicine education of other countries.

**TSENG, Tien-Tse**

Dr. Tseng, acquired his doctorate degree from Beijing University of TCM, developed and refined his skills through the guidance and mentorship of the internationally renowned Dr. Wei-Chieh Young, and Professor Qingguo Wang of Beijing University of TCM. Dr. Tseng has been using Tung's Acupuncture system and has accumulated years of clinical practice in TCM, especially the Ttaumatology. He invented an integrated protocol namely "herbs, tendons, extra points" with excellent clinical efficacy. In his talks, Dr. Tseng will introduce an integrated protocol of combining unique concepts of Tung's Acupuncture (Tai Chi perception and Qi motivating technique) for effectively and easily handling cases of traumatology and sport injuries, even without using needle. Dr. Tseng will also present a live demonstrate on how to apply those three special manual techniques he created to address patient's pain with simple and easy to operate steps.

**CHUANG, I-Hsing**

After six years of intensive training in neurosurgery in Germany and Austria, Dr. Chuang decided to step into the new field of alternative medicine since 1991. In 2005, he learned from Dr. Yamamoto about the YNSA (Yamamoto New Scalp Acupuncture) and found it is such an fascinating system. Dr. Chuang has acquired twelve years of profound understanding of the human nervous system and has incorporated his clinical experience to his repertoire. He seeks to further expand the clinical field of YNSA. His upcoming presentation in this symposium will focus on the unique diagnosis of WAD, and how to apply YNSA treatment especially for tough cases. On the basis of more than 20,000 cases accumulated in the last 10 years, with the combination of Western neuroanatomy and the Chinese meridian system, Dr. Chuang has developed a unique treatment module based on YNSA. It can be used to treat various types of pain and trauma as well as post-operative reactions of various sequelae. It has shown evidenced yet surprising positive results in WAD cases.

**CHEN, Chun-Ming**

Dr. Chen is the Chairman of Taiwan Clinical Chinese Medicine Association. He obtained his doctorate degree of TCM Gynecology from the Guangzhou University of TCM. Dr. Chen is from a family with at least 3 generations of famous reputation in TCM gynecology, especially experts in male and female infertility and stroke treatment. He has accumulated large amount of unique and valuable clinical experiences. This time he wishes to share his thoughts and precious experiences on "Wind Stroke". Stroke has been on the top of the list of causes in adult disability and has been on the top three diseases consuming most resources in medical care system. In addition to acupuncture, Chinese herbal medicine plays an important role in its treatment.

**DONG, Liu**

Dr. Dong has been the first line clinical physician for a long time. She has obtained intensive and solid training of treating and research proceeding of diabetes and its complications in Beijing. She also has excellent skills and experiences of treating fatty liver, hyperlipidemia, hyperuricemia, thyroid disease as well as many other diseases of endocrine. She also been involved in lots of clinical study projects on metabolic related diseases. In her presentation this time, she will focus on sharing the advantages of using TCM for the treatment of diabetes as well as contributing her unique clinical tips of being successful. In recent years, diabetes and its complications has been proven to be a multi-system involved disease, and its prevalence is climbing year after year. It is not very effective nor realistic to only apply the ideas of treating "Xiao Ke" for modern diabetic related syndromes. A new TCM approach is necessary to be considered and promoted in order to acquire significant breakthrough in clinical treatments. Dr. Dong will open a new window with what she has learned and experienced.
